There's a ton of solo shows on September's blockbuster exhibition calendar, but this season also adds a few star-studded group shows to the mix. So if you've still got some art-viewing fuel left in your proverbial tank, here are 3 group shows you won't want to miss this month.

"Naturally Naked" at Gary Tatintsian Gallery, Moscow

This Moscow exhibition takes another look at one of the most enduring and controversial questions of art history: how to depict the nude figure. Reflecting on everything from the Venus of Willendorf to <u>Gustave Courbet</u>'s scandalizing realism, this group show brings together a group of contemporary works by artists including Carroll Dunham, <u>George Condo</u>, and <u>John Currin</u> to underscore the humor, implicit eroticism, and changing artistic significance of the motif. Also featured are hyper-realist sculptures by <u>Bjarne Melgaard</u> and Tony Matelli, which will have you doing double-takes.

"Naturally Naked" is on view at Gary Tatintsian Gallery through November 22, 2019.
